U.S. 60 Chip Seal Work Began This Week in Curry County

COUNTY: Curry County

HIGHWAY: U.S. 60

CLOSEST CITY: Clovis

START DATE: Saturday, October 21, 2012

END DATE: Friday, November 30, 2012

PROJECT: The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began chip seal operations on Saturday, October 21, on a section of U.S. 60 in Curry County. The project includes approximately 80 miles of resurface work on U.S. 60 starting at Hull Street in Clovis and ending at Yeso west of Ft. Sumner. The work will cost approximately \$2.8 million.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS: During the project motorists can expect short delays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Drivers are asked to watch for maintenance personnel working in the area, observe temporary lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
