NMDOT to host a public information meeting on proposed U.S. 60/70/84 improvement through the City of Clovis

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) is hosting a public information meeting to gather input on aesthetic and safety improvements on U.S. 60/70/84 through the City of Clovis between Prince Street and Norris Street. The meeting will feature a presentation of various options for landscaping, infrastructure treatments, and intersection improvements.

The NMDOT is initiating a corridor study to obtain information on the existing roadway conditions, identify needs for improvement and develop and evaluate alternatives for roadway improvements. An environmental study will also be conducted.

The public meeting will be hosted at the Clovis-Carver Public Library, Wednesday, November 14, 2012, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. with a presentation at 6:00 p.m.

New Mexico Department of Transportation staff, engineering consultants, residents and interested stockholders will be in attendance.
