Restriping to enhance safety on U.S. 60 in Curry County

Restriping work on U.S. 60 to begin this week, Monday, November 26, 2012, crews will start restriping work at Yeso and work their way to Clovis. The work is expected to take a week to complete, weather permitting.

The new striping will be easier to see and will enhance safety for those traveling this route. It is critical that motorists maintain a safe distance behind striping equipment. Motorists are asked to stay 500 feet back from striping truck, DO NOT CROSS WET MATERIAL, and are encouraged to avoid area being striped when possible.

The public's patience while operations are in progress is appreciated. Temporary traffic control measures will be in place, while work is taking place.
