Crack-sealing work on U.S. 70 began this week in Otero County

COUNTY: Otero County

HIGHWAY: U.S. 70

CLOSEST CITY: Tularosa

START DATE: Tuesday, December 11, 2012

END DATE: Sunday, December 16, 2012

PROJECT: The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will be filling pavement cracks on U.S. 70 in Otero County near Tularosa. The \$170,000 project will prolong the life of the highway. All work is expected to be complete by the end of the week, weather permitting.

WORK: Other roads scheduled for crack-sealing work in Southern New Mexico include U.S. 380, U.S. 82, U.S. 60, U.S. 54, N.M. 128, N.M. 48 and N.M. 205.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS: U.S. 70 will have one lane open in each direction while work is taking place. Hours of operation are from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., seven days a week. Please drive safely through construction zones.
