One lane of U.S. 70 to temporarily close Saturday, April 6, for Chiricahua Commemoration Celebration

Tularosa – The Chiricahua Commemoration Committee of Mescalero, NM in cooperation with the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will temporarily close the outside eastbound lane of U.S. 70 from Tularosa to Mescalero in Otero County on Saturday, April 6, 2013.

The Chiricahua Commemoration Celebration will include a walk/run, horse drawn buckboard wagons, horseback riders, walkers, and runner. The Mescalero Conservation Officers will be utilized for traffic control and the Mescalero Fire and Rescue will aid in any emergency response if the need arises.

Drivers may encounter delays during the special event, as well as brief, intermittent lane closures from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., on Saturday, April 6, 2013.
