Bridge Work To Continue May 17 U.S. 84/285 & North Tesuque Interchange

Santa Fe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will continue bridge rehabilitation work this weekend on U.S. 84/285 and North Tesuque Interchange (Exit 172) north of Santa Fe near the Tesuque Village (mile post 171.6). This work includes the removal and replacement of the bridge approach slabs, bridge sleeper slabs, transition slabs and roadway improvements at the interchange.

Starting Saturday, May 17 at 5:00 a.m., the New Mexico Department of Transportation will continue bridge rehabilitation work and paving operations on U.S. 84/285 and the North Tesuque Interchange. The North Tesuque Interchange southbound exit will be **CLOSED**, and the U.S. 84/285 southbound lanes will be reduced to one lane. The crossroad at the interchange will be closed and there will be **NO** access from CR 73 to southbound U.S. 84/285. The southbound lanes will be **RE-OPENED** at 5:00 p.m.

Local traffic can use Exit 175 (Camel Rock) for access to the west frontage road. There will be no outlet from the west frontage road back onto U.S. 84/285.

The project changes will include additional weekend work and one lane closures. It is scheduled for completion in June.
