U.S. 70/380 Pavement Rehabilitation Work to begin Monday, May 20th, in Chaves County

Roswell – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin pavement rehabilitation work on Monday, May 20th, on 5 miles of U.S. 70/380 in Chaves County and U.S 380 (Second Street) east of the Roswell Relief Route to approximately 300-ft. west of Sycamore Avenue intersection. The project includes approximately 5 miles of pavement rehabilitation work and will cost approximately \$4.3 million. All work is expected to be complete July 31, 2013.

During the project motorists can expect short delays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. There will be single-lane closures while work is taking place. Motorists are asked to watch for construction personnel working in the area, observe temporary single-lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through construction zones.
