Sign replacement work begins this week on U.S. 70

Roswell – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin replacing aging signs on U.S. 70 route this week. The sign replacement project, will take place on U.S. 70 route from Otero to Chaves County. All work on this \$140,000 investment is scheduled to be completed by late-July 2014.

Work to replace the signing includes mobilization of equipment, removal of existing extruded signs, installation of new signs and poles, and traffic control. All closures in effect will take place between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
