U.S. 64 Pavement Preservation Work East of Blanco

Blanco - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began pavement preservation work on U.S. 64 from mile post 81.8 to mile post 87.8 Thursday, June 26. This pavement preservation work is a heater scarification process located approximately seven miles east of Blanco.

Motorists can expect minor delays Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. There will be one lane closures with a flagger and pilot car operation though the work zone.

The pavement preservation project is scheduled for completion mid -July. Cutler Repaving Inc. of Lawrence, Kansas is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, watch for construction personnel, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit.
