U.S. 54 temporary closure scheduled this week in Lincoln County

Carrizozo – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two is continuing construction work along the U.S. 54 corridor, with scheduled temporary day time closures to allow for blasting and debris clean up. The temporary closures are occurring around noon and will last approximately 30 minutes to increase safety for motorists and workers.

The \$29 million investment began in March, with completion anticipated in 2016. Work includes new roadway, crossovers, major structures, structure extensions and upgrades, earthwork, guardrail, wall barrier, permanent signing and striping, traffic control, bridge construction, and miscellaneous construction.
