U.S. 64 Pavement Preservation Work – Taos

Taos – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began pavement preservation work on U.S. 64 from mile post 250 to mile post 245 on Tuesday, September 2, 2014. This pavement preservation work is a heater scarification process located west of the U.S. 64/NM 68/NM 522 intersection near El Prado.

Motorists can expect traffic delays Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. There will be one lane closures with a pilot car operation though the work zone.

The pavement preservation project is scheduled for completion the latter part of September 2014. Cutler Repaying Inc. of Lawrence, Kansas is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, watch for construction personnel, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road conditions website, www.nmroads.com
