U.S. 84/285 Bridge at Guadalupe Street Santa Fe

Santa Fe–The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin bridge rehabilitation work on the U.S. 84/285 Bridge (mile maker 165.3) at Guadalupe Street on the north side of Santa Fe on September 24, 2014.

Starting Wednesday, September 24 from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the U.S. 84/285 southbound off –ramp to Guadalupe Street will be CLOSED. Motorists traveling south into Santa Fe can use Paseo de Peralta.

There will be a one lane closure on the U.S. 84/285 northbound lanes just north of Alamo Drive beneath the bridge at Guadalupe Street. The lane closure will be in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The bridge rehabilitation work is anticipated to be completed September 26, weather permitting.

The Federal Highway Administration and NMDOT have partnered to fund the improvements. Qualcon, Inc. is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe traffic control signs and obey speed limits. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website, <u>www.nmroads.com</u>
