US 84/285 Sweeping Operations To Begin March 17 Santa Fe to Pojoaque

Santa Fe – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin sweeping operations on US 84/285 from mile marker 165 (Alamo Drive) to mile marker 181 (Jct. of US 84/285 & NM 503) on March 17, 2015. The sweeping operation kicks off the NMDOT maintenance crews' schedules for cleaning activities and preparation for the annual El Santuario de Chimayo Walk.

Starting Tuesday, March 17, motorists can expect minor delays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. There will be one lane closure on the northbound and southbound lanes. NMDOT maintenance crews will begin sweeping the northbound lanes and then move to the southbound lanes.

The sweeping operation is scheduled for completion Friday, March 20, weather permitting. The NMDOT thanks you for your patience during this time.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, watch for maintenance personnel in the area, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit.
