## US 70/N. Main Change in Traffic Control Madrid Street and US 70/N. Main

**Las Cruces:** The New Mexico Department of Transportation along with Sandoval Construction continues with roadway reconstruction along US 70/North Main. The contractor is scheduled to adjust their traffic control at the intersection of US 70/North Main and Madrid Street.

The contractor will be removing a portion of the existing pavement by milling off a section of roadway in order to install utility lines. Concrete wall barriers will be extended in to the intersection, which will restrict motorists on Madrid Street to only have right turn access on to US 70/North Main. The through street and left turn lanes on Madrid Street will not be accessible to motorists as work is being performed. US 70/North Main traffic will have access to the through lanes and right turns only for motorists traveling in both directions.

The change in traffic control will be in effect by 6:00 pm **today**, Wednesday December 10<sup>th</sup> and is scheduled to be lifted by the end of business Wednesday December 24<sup>th</sup>.
