The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will hold a second series of public meetings to share information regarding potential improvements to US 82 between Artesia and Lovington, New Mexico. 

The meetings will present the latest information about the analyses and recommendations for the US 82 alternatives developed following the public meetings held last March. The NMDOT Project Team has evaluated the leading alternatives for their ability to improve safety and serve existing and future traffic. In addition, the NMDOT has prepared preliminary cost estimates, identified right-of-way needs, and drainage improvements, and completed a preliminary assessment of the impacts each alternative would have on drivers, communities, area industry, and the environment. The findings of the evaluations will be presented at the public meetings for public comment.

We welcome your participation and your feedback. Your comments will be used along with the analysis findings to select a preferred alternative. The preferred alternative will then be evaluated in detail for its economic, social, and environmental impacts and then advanced for design and implementation.
