

Building soon for DaimlerChrysler - Multi-Million $\hat{\mathbf{A}}\square$ Contract for AVL

AVL as overall contractor for DaimlerChrysler Motorenhaus III

(PRWEB) December 19, 2001 -- DaimlerChrysler AG has engaged AVL to build a seven-story testing and test bed facility for the Mercedes-Benz Technology-Center (MTC) at Untertýrkheim in Germany, containing a total of 60 test modules. The value of the contract for the 'Motorenhaus III' project is in the region of 100 million Euros. As overall contractor, AVL will take responsibility for project management, system integration, construction and commissioning of the whole undertaking, as well as delivering key systems e.g. in the areas of automation, indicating and fuel flow measurement. The 'Motorenhaus III' facility will be completed in 2004.
