Gray Tiger Racing Inc., located in Cave Creek, Arizona was incorporated in March 2002 for the purpose of creating a race team to compete in the Grand America Road Racing AssociationÂ \Box s new premier series, the Daytona Prototypes. The team is planning on having a car on the track by the end of this year and is planning on running a two car team in 2004.

The cars are designed by Terry Rohr, and the chassis and body designs have been approved by Grand American. Construction on the first chassis and body is planned to start by mid April. Current plans call for utilizing the Honda V-6 engine, however the engine configuration has not yet been approved by Grand American. Grand American requires all engines to be either six or eight cylinders, must be less than 5.5 liters, and the specific configuration must be approved by them. $\hat{A} \square$ We would love to run the Honda engines in these



cars. $\hat{A} \square$ said Rohr, $\hat{A} \square$ We realize that we might be giving up a little power to the V-8 $\hat{A} \square$ s, but feel that there is such a large following for Hondas here in the U.S. that we really would like to have Honda on the sides of our cars. $\hat{A} \square$
