## Pavement Preservation Work U.S. 70 in Chaves County

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two will begin pavement preservation work on U.S. 70 in Chaves County. The project includes 8 miles of pavement preservation work from mile marker 302 to mile marker 310 on the eastbound lanes just west of Roswell in Chaves County.

Shallow milling work will take place the week of April 24<sup>th</sup> and a surface treatment will take place this summer. This type of work is very weather dependent and affects the scheduling of work.

Motorists are asked to watch for construction personnel working in the area, observe temporary lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
