# MANDATORY STOP-SALE ORDER Upcoming Voluntary Safety Recall 69i9

DO NOT SELL, LEASE OR DEALER TRADE ANY AFFECTED VEHICLE

Dear Volkswagen Dealer Principal, Service Manager, and Parts Manager:

Volkswagen has notified the NHTSA and Transport Canada of an upcoming voluntary safety recall affecting some 2012-2013 model year Volkswagen Beetle vehicles equipped with leather sport seats. Because of this, effective immediately, certain 2012-2013 model year Volkswagen Beetle vehicles equipped with leather sport seats are under a mandatory stop sale order.

#### What should dealers do?

- Affected vehicles will be identified on your VIM report with the campaign code 69i9 on or about November 20, 2012. Check your VIM report to see if you have any in-stock vehicles affected by this mandatory stop sale. Only dealers with inventory vehicles affected by this action will see vehicles tagged with 69i9 on their VIM report.
- If you have an affected vehicle, <u>**DO NOT**</u> sell, lease, or dealer-trade it. If you are using an affected vehicle as a demo, discontinue doing so immediately. Please keep any affected vehicle in a secure area where it cannot be made available for sale, lease or trade.

#### What will Volkswagen do?

- Shortly, dealers will receive instructions from Volkswagen on what will be required for the affected vehicles.
- Affected dealers will be reimbursed for floor planning expenses related to the stop-sale hold vehicles until the repair instructions and parts allocation are released.

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION		Vehicles equipped with leather sport seats have been built with an incorrectly coded Passenger Occupant Detection System Control Module (J706) in the right front passenger location.  USA: If the leather seat gets wet and if a child restraint is secured on the right front passenger seat, the control module may not properly detect the child restraint. The right front passenger air bag will not be turned off as expected. The PASSENGER AIR BAG OFF light will not illuminate, alerting the driver that the passenger airbag has not been turned off.  CANADA: If the leather seat gets wet and if, despite safety warnings and provincial regulations, a child restraint is secured on the right front passenger seat, the control module may not properly detect the child restraint. The right front passenger air bag will not be turned off as expected. The PASSENGER AIR BAG OFF light will not illuminate, alerting the driver that the passenger airbag has not been turned off.  If the right front passenger airbag is not turned off when a child restraint is secured on the right front passenger seat, there is a risk of serious injury to the child seated there in the event of a crash with airbag deployment.
