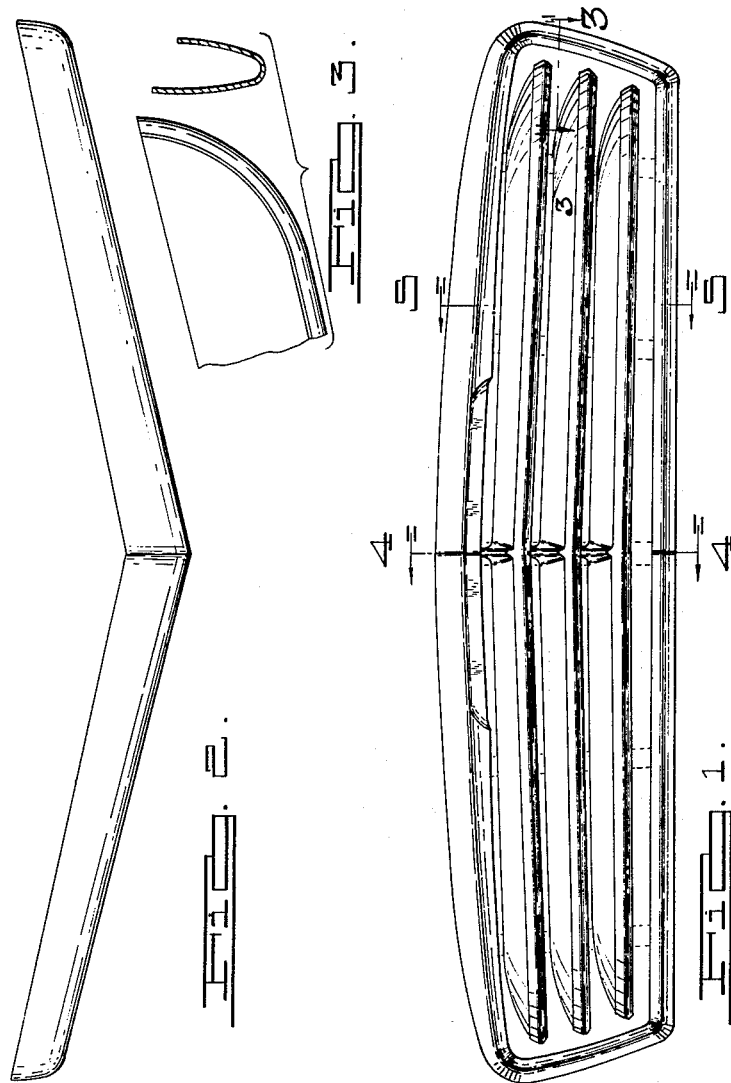

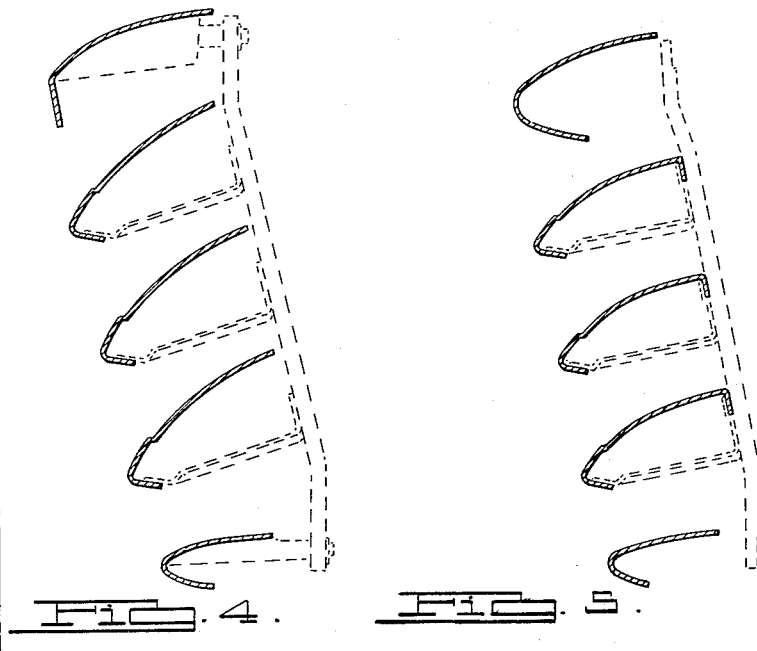


Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of an automobile grille showing my new design;
