NM267 at Melrose Closed for Work at Railroad Crossing

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) announces the closure of NM267 in Melrose at mile marker 32 on Monday, May 21, 2012 at Noon until Tuesday, May 22, 2012 at 4:00pm. The Northern Burlington Railroad will be doing work on the Railroad Crossing. Traffic will be detoured through Melrose until work is completed.

Barricades will be in place and detour signs will be up to alert the traveling public of the work. The Department has contacted the emergency personnel in the area to advise them of the closure.

Please drive carefully, observe posted warning and speed limit signs, and watch for construction workers in the area.
