St. Michaels Drive Mill and Inlay Construction between Llano Street and Galisteo Street

Santa Fe - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin a Mill and Inlay project on various intersections along St. Michaels Drive between Llano Street and Galisteo Street on June 24.

Starting Sunday night June 24, the Mill and Inlay operations will be completed at nighttime. This project is anticipated to last three weeks with an anticipated completion date of July 12, weather permitting.

The existing roadway surfacing will be milled out and a 2"scarification overlay will be placed. This work will be completed at various intersections along St. Michael's Drive between Llano Street and Galisteo Street.

Cutler Repaying Inc. out of Lawrence, Kansas is the contractor for this project

The contractor will work Sunday nights through Friday nights. There is no work scheduled for Wednesday July 4th. The contractor will resume work on Thursday night, July 5th.

During the project motorists can expect minor delays between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., Sunday through Friday nights. Drivers are asked to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe temporary traffic control signing, and observe posted speed limits.
