N.M. 48 Pavement Rehabilitation Work to begin Thursday, October 4, in Ruidoso

COUNTY: Lincoln County

HIGHWAY: N.M. 48 (Through Ruidoso)

CLOSEST CITY: Ruidoso

START DATE: Thursday, October 4, 2012

END DATE: Friday, October 12, 2012

PROJECT: The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin pavement rehabilitation work on Thursday, October 4, on a section of N.M. 48 in Ruidoso. The project includes approximately 2 miles of pavement repair from Paradise Canyon to Downtown Ruidoso. The work will cost approximately \$175,000 and will begin Thursday, October 4th and is expected to be complete Friday, October 12th.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS: During the project motorists can expect short delays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Motorists are asked to watch for construction personnel working in the area, observe temporary single-lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through construction zones.
