N.M. 209 Chip Seal Work to begin Monday, October 15, in Curry County

COUNTY: Curry County

HIGHWAY: N.M. 209 (North of Clovis)

CLOSEST CITY: Clovis

START DATE: Monday, October 15, 2012

END DATE: Friday, October 19, 2012

PROJECT: The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin chip seal operations on Monday, October 15, on a section of N.M. 209 in Curry County. The project includes approximately 5 miles of resurface work on N.M. 209 starting at mile marker 2 and go to mile marker 7 just north of Clovis. The work will cost approximately \$200,000.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS: During the project motorists can expect short delays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Drivers are asked to watch for maintenance personnel working in the area, observe temporary lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
