NMDOT HOSTS PUBLIC MEETING FOR THE NM 460 DRAINAGE PROJECT

ANTHONY, NM – **October 26, 2012** – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) is proposing to improve drainage facilities located in the Town of Anthony, New Mexico. The NMDOT will be hosting a public meeting for the proposed project on November 1, 5:30-8:00 p.m. at the Anthony Water & Sanitation District Office, 1155 N. Fourth Street, in Anthony, NM. Interested members of the public are invited to attend the public meeting to learn about the project and make comments. This will be the first of two public meetings that will be held for the proposed project.

The NMDOT is committed to involving the public in a collaborative process for NM 460 Drainage Improvement Project. Proposed improvements will include the installation of a storm drain trunk line with curb and gutter on the east side of NM 460 between Miller Street and Acosta Road. Drainage from the existing laterals located in the project area will be transported either to a retention pond or an existing drain. Pedestrian facilities will also be installed.
