I-25 Truth or Consequences to Socorro, NM

The NMDOT in conjunction with Apache Construction will be working on guardrail upgrades between the mile markers 83-175 from February 2013 until November 2013. The contractors daily operations will be daily including weekends from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Motorists will encounter lane drops and reduction in speed at various locations throughout this project.

I-10 Lordsburg, NM

The NMDOT will be conducting maintenance repairs on I-10 going eastbound. The right lane will be closed from mile marker 29-30, starting Monday June 10, 2013 at 7:00 a.m. and will remain closed until the end of business Thursday June 13, 2013 at 3:30 p.m. Motorists are advise to proceed with caution and to obey traffic control.

US-70/Picacho Avenue, Las Cruces, NM

The NMDOT and Star Paving will be performing repair work around the manholes and water valves, which will be done along the inside lanes. Traffic will be restricted to one lane for traffic traveling east and westbound from Main Street to Valley Drive, then will continue work between the Rio Grande to N. Motel Blvd . Motorists will encounter lane closures throughout this work zone. Business owners and residents will still have access on Picacho, yet the traveling public may encounter delays, due to heavy equipment and paving operations. Motorists are advised to proceed with extreme caution.

US-70 Del Rey Blvd. to NASA Exit, Las Cruces, NM

The NMDOT with Smith and Aguirre Construction continue construction along US-70 from Del Rey Boulevard Exit (151 exit) to NASA Exit (161 exit). The contractor will have 12 foot lane restrictions in two mile increments. There will be inside lane closures from Holman Exit to Rinconada Blvd. due to placing guardrail by San Bar Construction. The operations will be ongoing Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. during this time motorists will

encounter the inside lane closure as vehicles approach the work zone throughout the duration of the project.

NM-9 Animas, NM

The NMDOT will be blade patching on NM-9 from mile marker 33-38. Working operations will start at 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. Monday June 19, 2013 through Friday June 14, 2013. Traffic control will be placed throughout the project. Please proceed with caution while going through the project and obey traffic control.

NM-28, Anthony, NM

The NMDOT will be conducting a roadway reconstruction on NM-28 from mile marker 6-7. These operations will start at 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. on Monday June 10, 2013 until Friday June 14, 2013. The roadway reconstruction will involve removing unsuitable materials to stabilize the surrounding area. Traffic control will have flagman conduct traffic throughout the one lane road. Motorists should expect to stop and expect delays. Please proceed with caution and obey traffic control.

NM-90 Silver City, NM

The NMDOT in coordination with Vis-Com, Inc. will be installing new radar units at the intersection of NM-90 and 12th street in Silver City, NM. The start date will be Monday June 10, 2013 until Wednesday June 12, 2013. The daily operation time will start at 8:00 a.m. and last until 3:30 p.m., during this time there will be left lane closure approaching the intersection. Motorists are advised to proceed with caution and to obey traffic control.

NM-90 Tyrone, NM

The NMDOT along with Cutler Repaving will be performing roadway maintenance work on NM-90 between mile markers 22.5 to 27.0 with an overlay with scarification process. Maintenance work will take place Monday through Saturday beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. until the project is complete. Traffic control will be in place with a pilot car assisting during working operations. Motorist should expect delays and proceed with caution.

NM-136 Anthony, NM

The NMDOT along with C.F. Jordan Construction, LLC will continue roadway rehabilitation on NM-136 from mile marker 4.2-9.33. The westbound driving lane on NM-136 is closed at the intersection of Strauss/NM-136 for approximately ¼ of a mile with a 45 MPH speed limit. In addition the westbound shoulder on NM-136 will continue to be closed from mile marker 6.0 to the Texas state line until the completion of the path. This project will periodically have a single lane closures along the entire length of the project. Shoulder work will be throughout the project at various locations along NM-136, please proceed with caution and obey traffic notifications.

NM-136 Santa Teresa, NM

The NMDOT will like to advise the traveling public that the NMDOT will continue to improve the pavement in the parking lot at the Santa Teresa, NM Port of Entry on NM-136. As of now this operation has no impact on the traveling public.

NM-192 Antony, NM

The NMDOT with BNSF Railway will continue maintenance repairs on NM-192 until the end of business on Monday June 10, 2013. The route is a full rehabilitation, which requires the roadway to be completely closed.

Other routes that will encounter detours will be Snow Road, Onnie Acres, and Richardson Road. Motorists are encouraged to avoid these areas until the work zones are lifted as closures cannot be removed until work is completed. Motorists are asked to obey traffic alert and follow any detours that may be posted as BNSF conducts work along various routes within southern New Mexico.

NM-273 Anthony, NM

The NMDOT along with C.F. Jordan Construction, LLC will be conducting roadway rehabilitation on NM-273 from mile marker 6.52-9.33. Eastbound driving lanes are closed on NM-273 from mile marker 6-8, a total of two miles for mill and inlay operations. As Milling continues, the repaved roadway will be open to the public by 6:00 p.m. every day. Westbound lanes will be closed between Airport Road and Strauss Road, mile marker 5.5-4.5 on NM-136. This closure will be during the first part of the week between 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. for mill and inlay operations. The westbound passing lane is closed between the mile markers 6-7 for reconstruction. The speed limit is set for 45 MPH and motorists are advised to proceed with caution and to obey traffic notifications.

Las Cruces Projects – City of Las Cruces

Alameda Boulevard

From Lohman Avenue through South Main Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Amador Avenue

From Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad to Community of Hope will have a right lane closure for east bound traffic. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Amador Boulevard

From Alameda Avenue to McSwain Street will have alternating lane closures. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses and residents can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Compress Road

From El Molino through Amador Avenue will have intermittent lane and road closures. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Doree Court

From Debra Street to the east end will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses or residents can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the

construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Manzanita Street and Fir Avenue

From Piñon Avenue to Virginia Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses or residents can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Santa Fe Street

From Spruce Avenue and Chestnut Avenue will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses or residents can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Main Street

From Chestnut Avenue to Cambridge Drive will have a right lane closure for motorists traveling north bound. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Northrise Drive

From Rinconada Boulevard to Roadrunner Parkway will have left lane closures. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Rinconada Boulevard

From Northrise Drive to Sonoma Ranch Boulevard will have shoulder work and alternating lane closures. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Telshor Boulevard and Commerce Drive

At their intersection will have shoulder work and alternating lane closures. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.

Water Street

From Main Street to Hadley Avenue will have shoulder work and a right lane closure. Access to businesses will be maintained. Motorists wanting to get to businesses can do so by following the detours in place. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution. Motorists using this road as a through route only should seek alternate routes if available.
