Resurfacing work began today on N.M. 48 in Ruidoso

Ruidoso – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began resurface work today at the intersection of U.S. 70 and N.M. 48 (Sudderth Drive) in Ruidoso. The project includes approximately 3.5 miles of pavement preservation on a portion of N.M. 48 (Sudderth Drive) in the City of Ruidoso. The work will cost approximately \$1.5 million and is expected to be complete this summer, weather permitting.

During the project motorists can expect short delays between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. Motorists are asked to watch for construction personnel working in the area, observe temporary single-lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through construction zones.
