NMDOT Safety Project Begins In Aztec

San Juan – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) began a safety improvement project on April 13 in Aztec. The project is on NM 516 (from mile post 7.4 to milepost 13.9) and on U.S. 550 (from mile post 159.9 to mile post 161.2). It includes ADA ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter and median paving.

There will be intermittent single lane closures on NM 516 and US 550. Motorists can expect minor delays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the work week. Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe traffic control signing and obey posted speed limits.

This \$701,492 safety project is funded by the NMDOT and is scheduled for completion in the summer of 2014. H.O. Construction Inc. of Albuquerque is the contractor for this project.
