NM 529 Rehabilitation Project Public Information Meeting Tuesday, September 17, 2013

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will be holding a public information meeting on Tuesday, September 17 at the Lea County Event Center (5101 N Lovington Hwy, Hobbs, NM 88240, front meeting room) to discuss changes in scope to a rehabilitation project (CN 2100910) on NM 529 from Milepost 22 – 31.30 (intersection of US62/180)

A brief presentation to be given at 6:00 p.m. A question and answer session will follow.

The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate the deteriorating pavement and correct safety deficiencies on New Mexico Highway 529. The project begins at milepost 22 and proceeds east to milepost 31.30. This project includes cold mill and overlay of the driving lanes, installing new 8' shoulders, adding passing lanes, replacing or cleaning and repairing existing drainage culverts, and improving geometry at key intersections.
