This clinic is being held in conjunction with the 2013 Kidz In Motion National Child Passenger Safety Conference and the Manufacturers Alliance for Child Passenger Safety. It will provide parents and caregivers the opportunity to receive hands-on instruction from certified technicians on the correct use of child safety seats. Technicians will educate parents on choosing and installing the appropriate child safety seat for their child and vehicle. They can also determine if a seat has been recalled, expired or otherwise unsafe.

The clinic is a public service available to everyone and there is no charge for this service. Technicians will spend approximately 30 minutes per child safety seat has educating parents on the correct use and installation. Parents and caregivers must bring the child safety seat and, if possible, the child.
