Pavement Rehabilitation for NM 28 Mesilla to Texas State Line

Las Cruces - The New Mexico Department of Transportation's (NMDOT) District One Maintenance office will be performing pavement rehabilitation on NM 28 from Mesilla, NM to the Texas state line. The NMDOT will be placing a chip sealing product to assist in extending the longevity of the roadway.

The NMDOT will hold two public meetings to discuss the project details, time frame and traffic control restrictions that will impact motorists along this stretch of roadway.

The project is scheduled to start on Monday, June 16th at mile marker 0 (Texas State Line) with work on the northbound lanes through mile marker 28 (Mesilla, NM). Motorists will encounter lane restrictions in four mile increments as crews work on placing material along the roadway. There will be loose material along the shoulders and drivers are encouraged to reduce speed as sweepers will be stationed throughout the work zone in order to secure the passage of all vehicles.
