NM 41 Pavement Preservation Work To Begin June 16

Galisteo – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will start pavement preservation work on NM 41 from mile marker 62 (Junction of U.S. 285 & NM 41) to mile marker 57 on June 16, 2014. This five mile pavement preservation work is a heating, scarification and remixing overlay process.

Motorists can expect minor delays Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. There will be one lane closures with a flagger and pilot car operation though the work zone.

The pavement preservation project is scheduled for completion on June 20, weather permitting. Dustrol Inc. of Pueblo, Colorado is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, watch for construction personnel, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit.
