Pavement Rehabilitation for NM 28 Mesilla to Texas State Line

Las Cruces - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One Maintenance with Blue Collar Construction will be performing pavement rehabilitation on NM 28 from Mesilla, NM to the Texas state line. The NMDOT will be placing a chip sealing product to assist in extending the longevity of the roadway.

The project is scheduled to commence Monday June 16th at mile marker 0 (Texas State Line) and work on the northbound lanes until they reach mile marker 28 (Mesilla, NM). Motorists will encounter lane restrictions in four mile increments as crews work on placing the chip seal material along the roadway. Drivers will notice loose rock on the new roadway surface and are encouraged to reduce speed as sweepers will be stationed throughout the work zone in order to secure the passage of all vehicles.

Hours of operation will be Monday through Friday from 7:00 am - 5:00 pm daily weather permitting. The project is scheduled to be complete by Friday July 4^{th} .
