U.S. 285 Lamy Bridge Work To Begin July 14

Santa Fe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin bridge rehabilitation work on U.S. 285 near Lamy just north of NM 41 at mile post 284.1 on July 14, 2014.

Starting Monday, July 14 at 7:00 a.m., the U.S. 285 northbound and southbound lanes will be reduced to one lane. Motorists can expect minor delays. During the daylight hours, the northbound and southbound traffic will travel through one lane with a flagger and pilot car operation. During the night, there will be a temporary signal set up on the north and south end of the work zone. There is a 17' width restriction.

This bridge rehabilitation project is scheduled for completion later this month. The Federal Highway Administration and NMDOT have partnered to fund the improvements. Interstate Highway Construction of Albuquerque is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe traffic control signs and obey speed limits. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road conditions website, www.nmroads.com
