## Dark Canyon Bridge Work to resume in Carlsbad

**Carlsbad** - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will resume work on the Dark Canyon Bridge next week. The work is part of \$1.6 million project to improve three bridges in the Carlsbad area including; Dark Canyon Bridge, Hackberry Draw and Plaza Street Bridge, and Rocky Arroyo Bridge on US 62/180/285 north of Carlsbad

Work includes survey work, removal and replacement of worn areas, deck sealant and other miscellaneous rehabilitation work.

During this project, motorists can expect lane restrictions and temporary lane closures. Motorists are encouraged to use San Jose Blvd. The bridge improvement projects are expected to be completed this summer, weather permitting.
