NM 68 Pavement Preservation Work Taos

Taos—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin pavement preservation work on NM 68 from mile post 32 to mile post 39 Monday, August 4, 2014. This pavement preservation work is a heater scarification process located north of Pilar and south of Ranchos de Taos.

Motorists can expect traffic delays Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. There will be one lane closures with a pilot car operation though the work zone.

The pavement preservation project is scheduled for completion mid-September 2014, weather permitting. Cutler Repaying Inc. of Lawrence, Kansas is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, watch for construction personnel, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road conditions website, www.nmroads.com
