Chip Seal Operations in Lincoln County

Cloudcroft – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two began a project this week to chip seal pavement on various roadways in Lincoln, Eddy and Otero County.

The chip seal crew is working in Lincoln County along NM 244 from Cloudcroft to Mescalero.

Drivers may encounter flaggers where work is being performed, as well as brief, intermittent lane closures. Routes chip sealed this summer include NM 137, NM 349, NM 37, NM 48, NM 220, US 70, NM 244, and US 82.

Chip seal is a surface treatment on the pavement in an effort to preserve the life of the pavement surface by sealing out moisture, which can cause damage to pavement.

Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
