



Albuquerque (August 19, 2014) – Traffic Report

This report replaces previous report.







<u>Wednesday 8/20 from 8 pm to 6 am each evening</u> _ I_25 northbound at Paseo Del Norte will be closed.

<u>Wednesday 8/20 and Thursday 8/21 from 9 am to 3 pm each day - San Antonio eastbound at the northbound frontage road will have the right lane closed.</u>

- Ongoing and until further notice Tiburon at Jefferson will be closed.
- Ongoing until further notice The I_25 northbound onramp from Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- <u>Ongoing and until further notice</u> The I_25 southbound Frontage Road from Paseo Del Norte to San Antonio will be one lane only.
- Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit) The I_25 northbound frontage road from San Mateo/Osuna to just past Forest Hills will be reduced to one lane only. All lanes are restored just after Forest Hills.
- Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit) The I_25 northbound frontage road before
 Paseo Del Norte will be reduced to one lane. Frontage road traffic must merge with I_25
 northbound off ramp traffic.

Monday 8/18 through Thursday 8/21 from 8 pm to 5 am each evening—U_S 5_50 both directions from N_M 3_13 to I_25 (Bernalillo) will have various lane closures to perform minor repairs through project.

<u>Project A300940 /Rio Bravo – Isleta Intersection Improvement (Emiliano Martinez Project Manager/AUI Contractor)</u>

- Ongoing and until further notice N_M 5_00 (Rio Bravo) at Isleta will switch all traffic onto the westbound lanes during construction. Two lanes of traffic each direction will be maintained. EXPECT DELAYS!!
- Ongoing and until further notice Isleta Boulevard at Rio Bravo will switch all traffic onto the northbound lanes during construction. Two lanes of traffic each direction (a through lane and a left turn lane) will be maintained. EXPECT DELAYS!!

<u>Project A300303 / I-40 / 98th Interchange Improvement (Jeremy Maestas Project Manager/AUI Inc. Contractor) Project will add an additional off ramp lane</u>

• Ongoing through Wednesday 8/13 from 7 am to 4 pm and 9 pm to 5 am - I_40 westbound at 98th street and Unser will have various single right lane closures.

<u>Project A300380 / N_M 528 Southern to Sundt/ Roadway Rehabilitation</u> (Patsy Najar/ Project Manager/Albuquerque Underground Inc.)

 Ongoing through Monday 9/22 - N_M 5_28 (DeArco Highway) both directions from Southern to Sundt will have a traffic switch onto the southbound lanes for roadway construction. Two lanes of traffic each direction will be maintained. EXPECT DELAYS!!

<u>DISTRICT WIDE TRAFFIC IMPACTS</u>

- Monday 8/18 through Friday 9/12 from 9 am to 3 pm days & 7:30 pm to 5:30 am nights (Albuquerque Asphalt) N_M 4_48 (Corrales Road) from Bessom Road to Jones Road will be reduced to a single lane. Flaggers will be onsite to move traffic through the work zone.
- Wednesday 8/20 and Thursday 8/21 from 6 am to 5 am each day I_25 both directions at mile marker 196.4 (north Belen Interchange) will have various lane closures for bridge deck maintenance.
- Ongoing through Wednesday 12/17 (RMCI/Town of Bernalillo)— U_S 5_50 both direction at Don Tomas (Bernalillo) will have various lane closures at night and daytime shoulder work for intersection improvements.
