NM 344 Pavement Preservation Work To Begin September 2

Edgewood—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin pavement preservation work on NM 344 from mile marker 1.9 (Dinkle Road) to mile marker 16 (San Pedro Hill) on September 2, 2014. This is a chip seal micro surfacing overlay process.

Motorists can expect minor delays Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. There will be one lane closures northbound and southbound with a flagger and pilot car operation escort through the work zone. NMDOT thanks you for your patience during this pavement preservation improvement project.

The pavement preservation project is scheduled for completion end of September 2014; weather permitting.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website www.nmroads.com
