### **Albuquerque (October 6, 2014) – Traffic Report**

Paseo Del Norte/I-25 Interchange  
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

- **Monday 10/6 from 7 pm to 4 am** - The I\_25 southbound off ramp to Paseo Del Norte will be closed. The I\_25 southbound frontage road from Alameda to Paseo Del Norte will also be closed during this time.
- **Monday 10/6 from 7 pm to 4 am** - Paseo Del Norte eastbound from 2<sup>nd</sup> street to the northbound frontage road will be closed.
- **Monday 10/6 and Tuesday 10/7 from 7 pm to 4 am** - Paseo Del Norte westbound from the northbound frontage road to Jefferson will be closed.
- **Tuesday 10/7 from 7 pm to 4 am** - I\_25 southbound from Alameda to Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- **Tuesday 10/7 from 7 pm to 4 am** - I\_25 northbound from San Antonio to Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- **Beginning Friday 9/5 at 7 pm and for 30 days** – Paseo Del Norte westbound will not have access to Jefferson.
- **Ongoing and until further notice**- The Jefferson onramp to I\_25 northbound will be closed. Use The San Mateo onramp to I\_25 northbound.
- **Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit)** – The I\_25 northbound frontage road from San Mateo/Osuna to just past Forest Hills will be reduced to one lane only. All lanes are restored just after Forest Hills.
- **Ongoing and until further notice (Kiewit)** – The I\_25 northbound frontage road before Paseo Del Norte will be reduced to one lane. Frontage road traffic must merge with I\_25 northbound off ramp traffic.

**Project A300411 /NM 333 MP 0.0 to 4.425 Roadway Improvement Project (Ed Mata Project Manager/Mountain States Constructors Contractor)**

- **Ongoing through Thursday 12/4 from 8 pm to 5 am and 9 am to 3 pm Sundays through Fridays** – N\_M 3\_33 from marker 0.0 to 4.425 (from Tramway east for 4 miles) will have various lane closures for roadway rehabilitation.

**Project A300940 /Rio Bravo – Isleta Intersection Improvement (Emiliano Martinez Project Manager/AUI Contractor)**

- **Ongoing and until further notice** – N\_M 5\_00 (Rio Bravo) at Isleta will have various lane closures. Two lanes of traffic each direction will be maintained. EXPECT DELAYS!!
- **Ongoing and until further notice** – Isleta Boulevard at Rio Bravo will have various lane closures. Two lanes of traffic each direction (a through lane and a left turn lane) will be maintained. EXPECT DELAYS!!

**Project A300380 / N M 528 Southern to Sundt/ Roadway Rehabilitation (Patsy Najar/ Project Manager/Albuquerque Underground Inc.)**

- **Ongoing and until further notice** - N\_M 5\_28 (DeArco Highway) both directions from Southern to Sundt will have various traffic switches for roadway construction. Two lanes of traffic each direction will be maintained. EXPECT DELAYS!!

**PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECTS**

- **Monday 10/6 through Friday 10/31 from 9 pm to 5 am weeknights and 9 am to 3 pm weekdays (Cutler)** – N\_M 45 (Coors) from St. Joseph's to Sequoia will have various lane closures for paving project. Night work will reduce Coors to one lane each direction.
