Reminder - NM 152 Kingston Roadway Work will Continue

Las Cruces - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One office has made the necessary roadway repairs throughout NM 152 that was initially closed due to flooding in September of 2014.

The NMDOT has lifted the closure for NM 152 in Kingston as crew members have repaired various sections of the roadway in order to have it passable and safe for the traveling public.

However, the NMDOT Maintenance Section will be working on NM 152 in the Silver City are at mile marker 30.1, as this section of the roadway will need to be closed in order to repair the culvert. The crew will commence work at 6:00 am on Wednesday November 19th with all restrictions lifted by 3:00 pm on Thursday November 20th.

The NMDOT encourages motorists and cyclists to proceed with caution as loose gravel still remain on various sections along this route and to obey all traffic notifications and speed limits especially as workers continue work on NM 152 and in any work zone."
