## NM 41- Installation of Bridge Girders To Begin October 27

**Galisteo**–The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) continues construction on the replacement of two bridges on NM 41 between mile post 55.53 and mile post 56.1, located just south of the Village of Galisteo at the San Cristobal Arroyo Bridge and the Galisteo Creek Bridge.

Starting Monday, October 27, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. through Thursday, October 30, there will be approximately 20 minute delays during the installation of bridge girders at the San Cristobal Arroyo Bridge and the Galisteo Creek Bridge. The northbound and southbound traffic will travel through one lane with a pilot car operation and temporary signal setup.

NO oversize vehicles or commercial loads are allowed through the work zone, and NO oversize loads allowed between Stanley and South of County Road 42. There is a 10' width restriction. Motorists traveling south on NM 41 can use U.S. 285 south to Clines Corners to I-40. Motorists traveling north on NM 41 can use I-40 east to Clines Corners to U.S. 285 north. The detours are equivalent to approximately 21 miles.

The NMDOT would like to thank you for your patience during this bridge improvement project.

Drivers are urged to proceed through the work zone with caution, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted speed limits. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road conditions website, <u>www.nmroads.com</u>
