NMDOT to host Public Information Meeting to discuss findings of Alignment Study along Sudderth Drive/NM 48 in the Village of Ruidoso

Ruidoso– The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will be holding a public information meeting on Thursday, November 20th, 6:00 p.m. at Ruidoso Convention Center located at 111 Sierra Blanca Drive in Ruidoso to discuss the findings of an Alignment Study along Sudderth Drive/NM 48 in the Village of Ruidoso.

The purpose of the study is to evaluate and develop transportation improvements to the Sudderth Drive corridor to improve access, reduce traffic congestion, and to create a pedestrian and bicycle friendly experience. The meeting will include a review of the existing conditions/issues within the corridor, the findings from the traffic and parking analysis, and an overview of all conceptual alternatives. The purpose of the meeting is to solicit feedback on the study's findings and the refined alternatives being presented.
