Bridge Work to begin in Curry and De Baca County

Starting this week, bridge replacement work will take place at NM 209 near Broadview in Curry County. In addition, bridge preventative maintenance work will take place on two bridges along US 84 in De Baca County. The work is part of a \$4 million project to improve three bridges, one near Broadview and two near Ft Sumner.

Work includes:

- NM 209 bridge at mile marker 20 in Curry County – removal and replacement of structure
- US 84 bridge at mile marker 7 in De Baca County – preventative maintenance
- US 84 bridge at mile marker 18 in De Baca County – preventative maintenance

During the projects, motorists can expect lane restrictions and temporary lane closures. Motorists are encouraged to use caution while driving through the work zones. The bridge improvement projects are expected to be completed winter 2016, weather permitting.
