# Albuquerque (December 3, 2014) – Traffic Report

This report replaces previous report.



- <u>Wednesday 12/3 from 7 pm to 6 am</u>— The I\_25 southbound off ramp to Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- <u>Wednesday 12/3 from 7 pm to 6 am</u>— The I\_25 southbound frontage road from Alameda to Paseo Del Norte will be closed. Local access will remain open.
- <u>Wednesday 12/3 and Thursday 12/4 from 7 pm to 6 am each evening</u> Paseo Del Norte eastbound from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to the northbound frontage road will be closed.
- <u>Wednesday 12/3 and Thursday 12/4 from 7 pm to 6 am -</u> Paseo Del Norte westbound from the San Pedro to Jefferson will be closed.
- <u>Wednesday 12/3 and Thursday 12/4 from 7 pm to 6 am -</u> I\_25 northbound from San Mateo to Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- <u>Wednesday 12/3 and Thursday 12/4 from 7 pm to 6 am Jefferson both directions</u> under Paseo Del Norte will be closed.
- <u>Wednesday 12/3 and Thursday 12/4 from 7 pm to 6 am –</u> San Antonio/Ellison both directions under I\_25 will be closed.
- <u>Thursday 12/4 from 7 pm to 6 am</u>-I\_25 southbound from Alameda to Paseo Del Norte will be closed.

<u>Project in suspension</u> – N\_M 3\_33 from marker 0.0 to 4.425 (from Tramway east for 4 miles) will be placed in suspension pending final paving in the Spring.

#### <u>Project A300940 /Rio Bravo – Isleta Intersection Improvement (Emiliano</u> <u>Martinez Project Manager/AUI Contractor)</u>

 <u>Project suspended until Spring 2015</u> – N\_M 5\_00 (Rio Bravo) at Isleta has all lanes restored and in the final configuration. Temperature dependent items needing to be completed will occur in the spring.

#### <u>Project A300380 / N\_M 528 Southern to Sundt/ Roadway Rehabilitation</u> (Patsy Najar/ Project Manager/Albuquerque Underground Inc.)

• <u>Spring of 2015 - N\_M 5\_28</u> (DeArco Highway) Final paving will occur as soon as temperatures allow. This will be followed by the final hot thermo striping.

## **PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECTS**



- <u>Saturday 12/6 from 7 am to 3 pm (Tom K. / Maintenance)</u>- I\_25 southbound at mile marker 227 will have various double lane closures for sign structure maintenance. The 2 right lanes will be closed first then changing to a double left lane closure. Use caution and reduce your speed through the work zone.
- <u>Saturday 12/6 from 4 am to 6 am (HP Communications)</u> N\_M 5\_28 both directions at Sara Road (Rio Rancho) will have intermittent full closures for overhead utility installation.
- <u>Sunday 12/7 from 7 am to 7:30 am (PNM)</u>-I\_25 both directions at mile marker 244.8 (Approximately 2 miles north of Bernalillo) will have intermittent full closures for overhead utility installation.
- <u>Monday 12/8 to Thursday 12/11 from 9 am to 3 pm each day</u> N\_M 6 northbound just before the junction with N\_M 47 (Los Lunas) will a single lane closed for utility installation.

- <u>Ongoing through Friday 12/5 from 7 am to 4:30 pm each weekday</u>- N\_M 45 (Coors) both directions at Raymac Road will have various lane closures for storm drain replacement.
- <u>Ongoing through Tuesday 12/9 from 9:30 am to 3 pm (PNM)</u>– I\_40 both directions just east of the river will have activity on the shoulders for overhead utility installation.
- <u>Ongoing through Tuesday 12/9 from 9:30 am to 3 pm (PNM)</u> N\_M 45 (Coors) both directions just south of Quail will have activity on the shoulders for overhead utility installation.
