NM 76 Slope Stabilization Work To Begin March 23

Espanola—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin slope stabilization emergency work on NM 76 at mile maker 14.5. The work zone is located between Cordova and Truchas.

Starting Monday, March 23 there will be a one lane closure on the southbound lanes of NM76 with a flagman operation from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The slope stabilization work is scheduled for eight (8) weeks and is anticipated to be completed by mid-May 2015.

Geo Stabilization International of Grand Junction, Colorado is the contractor for this project.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website www.nmroads.com
