Bridge Maintenance Repair Work Continues On Various State Roadways

Las Cruces – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One office with HASSE Construction continue performing maintenance repair work on various state-owned bridges where motorists will encounter intermittent lane closures.

The contractor will be working Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. where traffic control will be placed within the workzone alerting motorists of the lane and speed restrictions. The NMDOT will post roadway notifications of the work as it transitions from one location to another on www.nmroads.com. The routes affected will be as follows:

- US 70/Picacho Ave mile marker 141 in Las Cruces over the Rio Grande
- NM 192 mile marker 1.09 near Anthony, NM
- NM 225 mile marker 1.2 near Anthony, NM
- NM 157 mile marker .0 near Radium Springs

The contractor will be repairing the existing bridge decks and sealing the deck surfaces, which will assist in extending the longevity of the bridge surface.
