Chip Seal Operations to Begin in Lincoln County

Ruidoso – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two will begin a project to chip seal pavement on various roadways in Lincoln County.

The chip seal crew will begin work on Monday, May 4th along NM 368 near Hondo.

Drivers may encounter flaggers where work is being performed, as well as brief, intermittent lane closures. Additional routes scheduled for chip seal work include the frontage roads through Hondo and NM 244.

Chip seal is a surface treatment on the pavement in an effort to preserve the life of the pavement surface by sealing out moisture, which can cause damage to pavement.

Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
