## **I-25 Utility Work & Lane Closures Scheduled For Sunday August 2**

**Santa Fe**—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) has issued a utility work permit to the Public Services Company of New Mexico for placement of a new overhead power line on I25 at mile marker 273 south of Santa Fe. The closures are necessary for the safe placement of the power line.

Starting Sunday, August 2, from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., the I-25 northbound and southbound lanes will be reduced to one lane. There will be a series of ten minute closures on the I-25 northbound, southbound lanes and frontage roads to install overhead lines. Traffic can expect delays during this time.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website [www.nmroads.com](http://www.nmroads.com)
