Lane Closures To Begin On Guadalupe Street - December 9

Santa Fe—The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin paving operations on Guadalupe Street in the vicinity of the National Cemetery and near U.S. 84/285 (mile maker 165.3) on ramp north of Santa Fe.

Starting Wednesday, December 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Guadalupe Street will have intermittent lane closures on the southbound and northbound lanes. Motorists can expect minor delays during this time.

The paving operation work is scheduled to be completed December 9, 2015; weather permitting.

Drivers are urged to proceed with caution through the work zone, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted limit.
